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**Executive Order Number 25-038
Compliance Reporting**

Governor Landry and Honorable Members:

In accordance with the Administrative Procedure Act (La. R.S. 49:950 *et seq*) and the Louisiana Real Estate License Law (La. R.S. 37:1430 *et seq*), the Louisiana Real Estate Commission ("Commission" / "LREC") respectfully submits the following report in compliance with Governor Landry's April 1, 2025, *Executive Order Number 25-038* and the annual reporting requirements of La. R.S. 49:964(D) and 966(K).

The Commission has reviewed one hundred percent (100%) of its current administrative rules, conducting open meetings on August 21, 2025, October 16, 2025, and November 19, 2025 to comply with *Executive Order Number 25-038*.¹ The Commission is also scheduled to meet again in open meeting on Wednesday, January 14, 2026 to finalize the proposed rules changes and

to authorize promulgation thereof in accordance with law. The Commission has reviewed the rules and proposed changes to determine whether all are necessary, consistent with applicable law, aligned with the mission to protect the public interest by reasonably regulating Louisiana's real estate industry, and whether the benefits of the rules and proposed changes outweigh their burdens and costs.

The current draft of the proposed amendments being considered by the Commission makes comprehensive technical changes; reduces the overall length, number, and complexity of regulations; uses more concise, plain language; and, repeals or greatly reduces current rules that are redundant of existing statutes. Accordingly, please see the attached, proposed amendments in their current posture.²
